**Foster, Judith Ann Robertson.** 6 leaves.

Reminiscences, August 1918, of Judith Ann Robertson Foster (1845-1924) of Richmond, Virginia, detailing her life in Chesterfield County, Virginia, during the Civil War, including the siege of Petersburg and the occupation of Richmond, by Union troops. Foster also mentions her marriage to Eldridge Marcellus Foster (1841-1907) and the births of their children. Reminiscences are a transcribed copy. Gift of Minor T. Weisiger, Richmond. (51938)

**Hawkins, Myra W.** 32 leaves.

Civil War muster roll for Madison County, Virginia, compiled by Myra W. Hawkins in 1960. Muster roll lists the military units raised in Madison County, providing names of soldiers and details of their service. In addition, there are copies of court records from Chesterfield and Henrico Counties and Lynchburg and Richmond, Virginia, including judgments and chancery suits, where a particular craftsman was named as a party in the case. Includes a letter, 25-27 June 1968, from Mary Jane McLean to Alice and Bertha Reilly describing her life in Malaga, Spain; as well as Christmas cards. Collection also contains photographs of the Reillys, family friends, horses, dogs, vacation sites, and homes, including Albemarle County, Ashland, and Richmond, Virginia; vacation trips to New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Nova Scotia, and Puerto Rico. Collection includes negatives of photographs and an empty matchbook from the Island Inn at Hobe Sound, Florida. Purchased. (51831)
