of Virginia being in perfect health do make my last will and
testament in manner and form following that is to say
1st I wish my Executors whom I shall hereafter appoint immediately
after my decease to advertise and sell all the perishable property I
may have and out of the proceeds of such sale pay my just and
legal debts and if my perishable estate should be insufficient to pay
the same it is my further desire that they sell one of my Negro men
Jim or Charles or both if required and pay all such debts as I
may lawfully owe.

2^{dy} It is my desire and wish and I do hereby give and bequeath
unto my old servant Susan her freedom and liberty and for her
meritorious services it is my earnest request that my Executors whom
I shall hereafter appoint to release and set her at ^{perfect} liberty the I do hereby
Susan and to act as trustees for her in every instance and I do hereby
make the following provision for her maintenance for my said servant
Susan 1st I Give and bequeath unto her and her heirs forever the
following property to wit one feather bed and furniture one dark oak
loom one spinning wheel three chests all my kitchen ware and furniture
one trunk with all her clothing wearing apparel and bed clothes and
coffee mill and six sad irons and cupboard and two Cars one horse
and cart of her choice one years provision for herself and horse ^{all} the
fowls on the plantation one sow and pigs and one cow and calf of her
choice

3^{dy} It is my further wish and request that if my debts are paid
without selling my two Negroes Jim and Charles that I leave and
bequeath them as follows that ~~they~~ my Executors may dispose of them
by hire by the year or otherwise at the option of ^{her} the said Susan for the
annual support of my old Negro woman Susan their Mother during
her life and at her death I do hereby Give them their freedom provided
she may be supported without the sale of them being required
and if she should remove to any free state it is my request that
my Ex^{ors} permit the s^d Jim and Charles to go with her and of
course receive their freedom

4th I Give and bequeath unto my servant Susan the land and
