Records, 1903-2011, of the Order of Americans of Armorial Ancestry, including applications and scrapbooks. The applications contain name, address, occupation, name of person from whom the applicant is descended, lineage, authorities as to arms and descent, and personal history of the applicant. The scrapbooks include an organizational history, constitution and by-laws, membership lists, correspondence, clippings, newsletters, photographs, and programs. **RESTRICTED**. **Virginia. Militia. 7th Regiment. Capt. Horace Timberlake's Company.** 2 volumes.

Orderly books, 1814-1815, of a company in the 7th Regiment of the Virginia militia commanded by Captain Horace Timberlake (ca. 1774-1866). There are two volumes covering the period 30 August 1814 to 25 January 1815 while the unit was stationed at Camp Fairfield, Mitchell's Spring, and Camp Carter. They include regimental, brigade, and general orders. There are also morning reports, inspection and provision returns, reports of camp equipage, arms, and munitions, and muster and pay rolls. Officers of the day and courts-martial proceedings are also noted. One volume was later used by John Winn (1789-1844), who served as an ensign in the unit, and has births of Winn family members and slaves recorded at the beginning, as well as accounts, some relating to the estate of Dr. John Wills (ca. 1769-1815). Purchased. (51794)

**Zuni Historical Society (Isle of Wight County, Va.).** 3 cubic feet.

Collection, 1875-2015, of the Zuni Historical Society in Isle of Wight County, Virginia, including a secretary's book containing minutes, as well as materials collected by the Society for a proposed museum, including calendars, clippings, genealogical notes on the Chapman, Raney, and Sadler families, miscellaneous notes and research, newsletters, obituaries and funeral programs, photographs, store ledgers of Robert A. Horne (1877-1941), and papers of the Bradshaw and Joyner families. Much of the material was used in the books *Zoo-Nye: A Story of the Village* and *Zoo-Nye Revisited: Continuing Story of the Village* by Jane March. Gift of Jane March, Zuni. (51775)

## PERSONAL PAPERS

***At a General Meeting of the Freeholders & Inhabitants of the County of Fairfax, at the Court House in the Town of Alexandria on Monday the 18th day of July 1774. George Washington Esqr. Chairman; Robert Harrison Gent. Clerk of the Said Meeting. Resolved...*** 10 pages.

Resolutions, 18 July 1774, adopted by citizens of Fairfax County, Virginia, rejecting British claim of authority over the American colonies. The twenty-six resolutions are commonly known as the "Fairfax Resolves." This version is in the handwriting of Robert Harrison, who served as clerk of the meeting at which the resolutions were adopted. Docketing on the back indicates that they were to be presented to George Washington and Charles Broadwater, Fairfax County's delegates to the First Virginia Convention in Williamsburg in August. **Butterworth, Carey Wilbur.** .675 cubic feet.

Papers, 1890-1947, of Carey Wilbur Butterworth (1868-1949) relating to his work as an agent for the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad at Doswell station in Hanover County, and later at Milford station in Caroline County, Virginia. The collection includes correspondence, much of it with William D. Duke (1873-1951), company general manager, and concerns employee hiring, wages, job performance, and working conditions at the two stations. There are also accounts and receipts, applications for weekly settlements, cartoons and drawings, certificates, check rolls, employee pay

receipts, freight bills and bills of lading, monthly accounts current, Order of Railroad Telegraphers materials, remittances, and retirement benefit information. Purchased. (51472)

**Church, Randolph W., Jr.** .9 cubic feet.

Papers, 1860-2010, of Randolph W. Church, Jr. (b. 1934) of Fairfax, Virginia, containing mainly genealogical research by him and his father Randolph W. Church, Sr. (1907-1984) and uncle Alonzo Church (1903-1995) on the Church family and the related lines of Armistead, Bleakley, Frazier, Gochnauer, Parker, Petticolas, Robbins, and Russell. The collection includes correspondence, deeds, military records, newsletters, tombstone inscriptions, and wills. Gift of Randolph W. Church, Jr., Fairfax. (51796)

**Drewry Family.** .9 cubic feet and 11 volumes.

Papers, 1868-1998, of Patrick Henry Drewry (1875-1947) of Petersburg, Virginia, and his son John Metcalf Drewry (1911-1978) of Alexandria, Virginia. The bulk of the collection covers the years 1910 to 1960. It includes correspondence, clippings, information on President Franklin D. Roosevelt's judicial reorganization proposal, invitations to keel layings and launchings of numerous ships, materials relating to the reorganization of Petersburg city government in 1917, memorial addresses delivered in Congress upon the death of Congressman Drewry, photographs, programs, research notes, and scrapbooks. **Kolbe Family.** 1.2 cubic feet.

Papers, 1886-2014, of the Kolbe family of Richmond, Virginia, namely John George Kolbe (1886-1953) and his wife Ruby Royal (Penick) Kolbe (1898-1976). Much of the correspondence relates to the health issues of their two infant sons, the medical care they received at Jefferson Hospital in Philadelphia, and the subsequent death of John G. Kolbe, Jr. (1922-1924) while there. The collection also includes accounts and receipts, baptismal and confirmation certificates, greeting cards, photographs, programs, will of Emily Loeffler (1856-1936), and a WWI induction order. Gift of Chris Kolbe, Richmond. (51777)

**Lambeth, Robert Bolling, Sr.** 13.95 cubic feet.

Papers, 1936-2007, of Robert Bolling Lambeth, Sr., (1915-1999) of Bedford County, Virginia, consisting of advertisements, articles, clippings, correspondence, magazines, maps, notes, photographs, reports, speeches, and other papers concerning Lambeth's activities as a member of the Roanoke River Basin Association, as a naval officer during World War II, as an organizer of various festivals, and as a candidate for political office. Papers highlight his interest in education, religion, conservation, law, and finance, among other topics. Gift of Elizabeth Lambeth Gereau, Bedford. (44706, 50556)



**Mitchell, Cary.** 1 leaf.

Commission, 17 July 1761, of Cary Mitchell (1729-1782) as collector at the lower part of the James River in Virginia. The document was signed by five commissioners of customs at the Custom House in London, and is a renewal of an earlier commission. Purchased. (51816)

**Nash Family.** 1.6 cubic feet.

Papers, 1919-1953, of the Nash family of Hylas, Hanover County, Virginia, including correspondence, greeting cards, and invitations and announcements. Most of the collection consists of letters written by Melvin Linwood Nash (1925-2014) while he was serving in the U.S. Navy during World War II, first at the U.S. Naval Amphibious Training Base in Bainbridge, Maryland, and then as a gunner's mate aboard the LCI (G) 559 in the South Pacific. Following the end of the war, Nash was stationed at the U.S. Naval Training and Distribution Center at Treasure Island, California. There is also correspondence between his parents prior to their marriage, and letters written to his mother and sister from friends and relatives. Purchased. (51764)

**Pierce Family.** .5 cubic feet.

Papers, 1910-1994, of the Pierce family of Norfolk and Portsmouth, and Cumberland County, Virginia, including clippings on the murder of Reverend Edward Sylvester Pierce (1870-1923) and subsequent court trial, Fork Union Military Academy diploma and yearbook, invitation, photograph, school certificate, and watercolor painting of the Avamere Hotel in Virginia Beach. Gift of Cheryl Pierce Grant, Bourne, Massachusetts. (51812)

**Roark, Elijah B., Jr.** 7 leaves, photocopies.

Reminiscences, 18 November 1994, of Elijah B. Roark, Jr. (1925-1996) of Halifax County, Virginia, concerning his combat experiences with the 16th Infantry during World War II. He writes about his training at Camp Shelby and Fort Meade, and in southern England, and his participation in the invasion of Omaha Beach on D-Day, as well as action at St. Lo, France, Mons, Belgium, and Stolburg and the Ruhr River Valley in Germany. Roark details the injuries he sustained during battle, and the medical care he received at hospitals in England and France. Gift of Karen Hux, Midlothian. (51784)

**Thompson, Charles, Jr.** .675 cubic feet.

Papers, 1794-1899, of Charles Thompson, Jr. (1789-1855) of Hanover and Louisa Counties, Virginia, including accounts and receipts, agreements and contracts, bonds and promissory notes, correspondence, estate administration records, muster fines, slave records, and suit papers. Papers, 1908-2015, of the Trumbo family of Dinwiddie and Rockingham Counties, and Colonial Heights, Virginia, namely Woodrow Wilson Trumbo (1912-1979) and his wife Myrtle Frances (Bacon) Trumbo (1919-2015). The collection includes accounts and receipts, an autograph book, book drafts, certificates and diplomas,

correspondence, diary entries, estate papers, genealogical notes, home sale and loan documents, report cards, and school exercises. There is also a copy of "Benjamin Trumbo of Brock's Gap, Va." compiled by Alva Trumbo Wood in 2002. Gift of Cheryl Gentry, Urbanna. (51790)
