May 1863, of Company E with status of its members; furlough, 10 September 1864, for Chew signed by J. C. Matheny, noting that Chew has never been absent without leave; and receipt, 22 April 1865, from W. H. Wood for a horse with a U.S. brand. Purchased. (51835)

Land grant, 30 August 1842, for 13 acres located in Scott County, Virginia, to William Erwin, Elisha Stewart, and Harman Stewart. Grant is signed by John Munford Gregory (1804-1888), lieutenant governor of Virginia. Gift of Shirley Barrett, Rock Island, Illinois. (51894)

**E.B.H.** 2 pages.

Letter, 24 August 1878, from E.B.H. at the Hamilton Institute in Washington County, Virginia, to a young woman declaring his love for her. The letterhead is for the Hamilton Institute, a school located in Washington County. Purchased. (51861)

**Foster, Thomas Hunton.** 6 leaves and 20 pages.

Letters, 1862-1864, from Thomas Hunton Foster (1835-1864) of Company H, 6th Virginia Cavalry, to his parents James William Foster (1808-1866) and Sarah Hunton Foster (1811-1888) of Fauquier County, Virginia, and to "Willie," as well as letters between James William Foster and Thomas Hunton Foster while the latter was a prisoner of war at Johnson's Island, Ohio. Internal evidence indicates that letters dated 13 February 1863, 5 March 1863, and 31 March 1863, were written in 1864. Gift of Anne Carter Foster Hindman, Gordonsville. (51879)

Loehr (1842-1915) of Richmond, Virginia, including booklets, brochures, buttons, invitations, photographs, programs, and ribbons relating to reunion activities of the First Virginia Regiment, the United Confederate Veterans, and other organizations. Papers, 1786-1995, of the Maury family of Caroline County and Fredericksburg, Virginia, Washington, D.C., Missouri, and Texas. The collection includes correspondence and subject files of Charles Broadnax Maury (1822-1906) and his wife Sallie Fontaine (Maury) Maury (1825-1915), and their son William Lewis Maury (1851-1927) and his wife Cora Wells (Sears) Maury (1860-1917). **McMullen, Fayette.** 1 leaf.

Petition, 1857, requesting that Fayette McMullen (1805-1880) of Scott County, Virginia, be appointed Marshal for the District of Columbia by the President. The petition is signed by John T. Harris (1823-1899) of Rockingham County, Virginia, who served as a Democratic elector in the 1856 presidential election, and James Craig (1818-1888) member of Congress from Missouri, among others. **Millner, Beverly R.** 1 volume (130 pages).

Transcript of the cohabitation register of Henry County, Virginia, compiled by Beverly R. Millner of Henry County, registering former slaves living together as husband and wife as of 27 February 1866. Register provides names, ages, and birth places of the couples, along with children's names, if any. Register provides name of former owners, as well as a list of African Americans who were free before 1865 and cohabiting. Register does not include widows, widowers, or their children. Includes index. Gift of Beverly R. Millner, Axton. (51772)

**Overholser, J. W.** 2 pages.

Letter, 12 December 1882, from J. W. Overholser of Clinchport, Scott County, Virginia, to Mr. Latture (probably James M. Latture, 1848-1922) of Silvacola, Sullivan County, Tennessee, stating that he will be unable to make a meeting unless necessary. He adds that he hopes Latture's child will feel better. Reverse contains beginning of a letter from Latture to Josiah Lyon of Washington County, Virginia. Purchased. (51863)
