Anderson writes of news from their childhood home, Riccarton, Scotland, news of George McFadzen's fatherhood, the prostitutes of Petersburg, Virginia, and the hunting in Virginia compared to Scotland. Letters, 1912-1913, undated, from Richard Evelyn Byrd, Sr. (1860-1925), in Richmond, Virginia, to Daniel Brosius Henderson, Sr. (1862-1940), in Washington, D.C. Byrd writes of possible meeting with Henderson, in Washington, on his way back from a trip to New York, as well as Governor William H. Mann's discussion of the "school land subject," during the Southern Governors' meeting in Richmond, and arranging to get Mr. Calhoun an appointment with the Governor. Purchased. (52105)
