BIBLE RECORDS

Gwyn Family. 6 leaves, photostasts.

Bible of Charles Robert Gwyn (1809-1892). Areas covered are Caroline, Gloucester, and Orange Counties, and Norfolk, Virginia; and Maryland and Texas. Bible printed in 1836. Other surnames mentioned: Barrett, Cluverius, Ogle, Sangston, Scott, Taliaferro, Thruston, and Tomkies. Gift of Anita A. Lustenberger, Portland, Oregon. (53242)

Johns Family. 8 leaves, photocopies.

Bible of Stephen Johns (d. 1802). Area covered is Amelia County, Virginia. Record includes a typed transcript. Bible printed in 1766. Includes birth records for enslaved persons. Other surname mentioned: Foster. Gift of Brett Potts, Chicago, Illinois. (53245)

Pitts Family. 2 leaves, photocopies.

Bible of Henry Pitts (1763-1807). Areas covered are Caroline and Essex Counties, Virginia, and Alabama and Oklahoma. Record is a typed transcript. Bible printed in 1763. Includes recordation of deaths of two enslaved persons. Other surnames mentioned: Catlett, Daniel, Oneal, Powers, Sale, Tharp, and Wortham. Gift of Wesley E. Pippenger, Tappahannock. (53243)

Bible of John Guyer Scarborough (1849-1925). Areas covered are New York and Pennsylvania. Bible printed in 1873. Other surname mentioned: Ramsey. Gift of Wesley E. Pippenger, Tappahannock. (53246)

C. W. Barksdale and Company (Halifax County, Va.). 1 volume (332 pages).

Account book, 1855-1859, of C. W. Barksdale and Company of Halifax County, Virginia, containing customers' accounts for purchases of alcohol, clothing, dry goods, farm implements, groceries, hardware, shoes, and other items. Includes an index. Purchased. (51875)

Coleman, William. 1 volume.

Ledger, 1813-1834, of William Coleman (d. ca. 1838) of Amherst County, Virginia, consisting of roster, payroll, and military orders, 1813, for Captain William Coleman's company, 90th Virginia militia; and of account book for Coleman as a merchant and partner in Coleman and Barret in Amherst County. Account book includes customer accounts. Purchased. (52099)

Davis, W. C. 1 volume (544 pages).

Business ledger, 1916-1921, of W. C. Davis (1858-1935), a hardware merchant in West Point (King William County), Virginia, containing clients' accounts and listing items purchased. Ledger also notes payment of accounts and includes an index. Purchased. (53197)

Norris Furniture Corporation (Richmond, Va.). 1.21 cubic feet.

Business records, 1949-1961, of the Norris Furniture Corporation of Richmond, Virginia, consisting of financial records containing inventories, 1956-1961 and undated, of furniture, including items sent to stores in Grand Rapids, Michigan, and High Point, North Carolina; financial records including balance sheets, 1949; and consignment papers, 1955-1956; ledger, 1957-1961, containing cash receipts and disbursements and sales journal and purchases; and payroll ledger, 1958-1961, recording earnings, deductions, and net pay of employees. Hankins and Johann (Richmond, Va.). 3 volumes.

Business ledgers, 1943-1975, of Hankins and Johann, a manufacturer of metal and aluminum products, located in Richmond, Virginia, consisting of an order book, 15 July 1943- 30 October 1945, placing orders for metalwork; and wage ledgers, 1948-1967 and 1968-1975, recording employees' wages and days absent from work. Gift of Robert M. Johann, Richmond. (52516)

Miller, J. H. 1 volume.

Ledger, 1910-1912, of J. H. Miller (b. ca. 1863), a horse dealer located in Richmond, Virginia, recording his sale of horses, mules, and wagons and including an index. Also includes loose papers consisting of correspondence, 4 June 1912, from the American National Bank; an advertisement for Roland H. Childrey, pharmacist; and notes. This volume was also used in the PBS television series "Mercy Street" and contains descriptions of three characters: Dr. Jedidiah Foster (p. 399), nurse Anne Hastings, and nurse Mary Phinney. People's Bank (Martinsville, Va.). 2 volumes.

Ledgers, 1897-1899, of the People's Bank of Martinsville, Virginia, also called note ticklers, recording notes, including the drawer, endorser, and amount. Volume 1 covers 1 March 1897-20 April 1898, and volume 2 covers 31 March 1898-24 May 1899. Purchased. (53241)

Unidentified. 1 volume.

Ledger, 1919-1930, of an unidentified slaughter house in Richmond, Virginia, containing accounts with Richmond butchers for meats. Butchers' names are given. Ledger also contains record of sale of eggs, berries, and other items. Purchased. (52202)

Virginia Bridge and Iron Company (Roanoke, Va.). 1 volume (495 pages).

Letter book, 2 July-12 October 1896, of the Virginia Bridge and Iron Company of Roanoke, Virginia, containing office copies of letters to companies, localities, and individuals regarding construction jobs or job bids in Giles and Smyth Counties, and Danville and Norfolk, Virginia; and Alabama, Georgia, Mississippi, North Carolina, and West Virginia, among other locations. Also includes letters to suppliers for materials for bridge construction. Purchased. (52082)

Worth While Bible Class (Augusta County, Va.). 1 volume.

Minute book, 1927-1948, of the Worth While Bible Class, a women's group at the Methodist Episcopal Church of Greenville in Augusta County, Virginia. The minutes record the business meetings of the class as it provided outreach and support for the church and the community. Includes an attendance roster, 1941-1948. Purchased. (53207)

Notes. Includes information on the descendants of Jeremiah Jarman (1673-1729) of Wales and Pennsylvania, including information on lines which settled in Fairfax and Hanover Counties, and Arlington, Hampton, and Richmond, Virginia, and Alaska, California, Connecticut, Florida, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, New Hampshire, New York, Ohio, Texas, and Australia. Other surnames mentioned: Arkinstall, Arnold, Broderick, Cassidy, Henry, Jansen, Jenkins, Mack, McDonagh, McManus, Mullins, Nunes, Rand, Scipio, Shahid, Smith, Stoller, Tomamichel, Welch, and White. Notes. Includes information on the descendants of John (Lipscomb) Robinson (ca. 1825-1908) of Cumberland County, and Lynchburg, Virginia, including information on lines which settled in Amelia and Nottoway Counties, and Richmond, Virginia. Other surnames mentioned: Coleman, Isbell, Johns, and Lipscomb. The volume highlights the fluidity of racial identity in Virginia in the 19th and 20th centuries. Will, undated, of John Baird of Prince George County, Virginia. The undated will bequeaths various tracts of land and enslaved persons to his daughter, Elizabeth Gordon, her two sons, John and William Westmore, and his son, William Baird. Among the enslaved persons named are Liddy Milly, and Setty. Purchased. (52439)

Gibson, John C. 2 pages.

Letter, 29 October 1891, from John G. Gibson (b. ca. 1847) of Richmond, Virginia, to unnamed recipient referred to as Growing Trade care of Clay Works Yard. Gibson, responding to an ad in the newspaper seeking someone to take charge of brick making business, describes his experience and method for making bricks and suggests equipment for brick making. Purchased. (52427)

Haxall, Philip. 1 volume.

Autograph book, 1858-1865, of Philip Haxall (1840-1897) of Richmond, Virginia, containing autographs of classmates at Hanover Academy and the University of Virginia, as well as friends in Richmond and Charlottesville, Virginia, and including photographs and clippings. Haxall annotated the autographs with the person's service during the Civil War. Also includes a letter, 13 October 1861, from General J. R. Anderson (1813-1892) offering Haxall a commission as his aide de camp. Gift of Malcolm Cameron. (53183)
