To help contain the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19), the Library of Virginia is **closed to the public until further notice**. Please check our website at lva.virginia.gov regularly for the most up-to-date information on our operating status. We are monitoring the developing situation closely and following directives from the Office of the Governor and guidelines from the Virginia Department of Health and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Library users who have books or other materials checked out are asked not to return them until the Library reopens. Loan periods will be extended and no fines will accrue while the building is closed. The Library has also suspended all in-person public events, workshops, programs, and tours until further notice. We hope to reschedule as many events as possible—and we're offering some webinars and virtual events—so please check our News and Events calendar at lva.virginia.gov/news/ and follow us on social media.
