		1607 – Jamestown settlers arrive.
		1775 – George Washington becomes commander-in-chief of the Continental Army.
		1861 – Virginia secedes from the Union.
		1902 – Virginia adopts its sixth constitution, which disenfranchises most black and many white voters.
		1912 – Virginia-born Woodrow Wilson is elected the 28th president of the United States.
		1936 – Built with Civilian Conservation Corps labor and materials, the first state parks in Virginia opened.
		1942 – In support of World War II, the Hampton Roads Port of Embarkation was activated.
